# 18th Anniversary Commemoration of 9/11

The September 11th Victim Compensation Program is running out of money and is in the process of cutting benefits to thousands of injured and ill responders, survivors and their families. In addition, unless Congress acts, the Fund will close in December 2020. We can't allow our heroes to lose the help they need, deserve and are expecting, which is why Citizens for the Extension of the James Zadroga Act, Inc. is working to mobilize support.
