

Statistics that show the Size and Scope of the 9/11 Health Crisis facing 9/11 Responders, Survivors and their Families

Below is information on the size and extent of the Health Crisis facing injured and ill 9/11 Responders and Survivors, including residents, student, and area workers.

- There are over [105,000 Responders and Survivors](#) who are living in [every State](#) and from [433 of 435 Congressional Districts](#).
- There are over [21,000 participating in the National Program](#) which provides medical treatment and monitoring for 9/11 Responders who live outside the New York Metropolitan Area, including responders to the Pentagon and the Shanksville crash site.
- There are over [79,000 9/11 Responders](#) receiving medical monitoring to safeguard against emerging injuries.
- There are [26,271 injured 9/11 Survivors](#) receiving medical treatment for their injuries from the World Trade Center Health Program.
- There are [58,933 Responders and Survivors](#) that have at least one 9/11 condition. Over two thirds of these people have more than one condition and many of those suffer from multiple injuries and illnesses.
- [35,806 9/11 Responders and Survivors](#) sought treatment last year, for their 9/11 injury from the World Trade Center Health Program.
- Over 2,000 active duty Fire Department personnel (Fire Fighters and EMS) and over 910 NYC Police Department personnel have had to retire due to disabling 9/11 injuries.
- [19,150 Responders and Survivors](#) have been certified to have a 9/11 related cancer, of which over 2,689 are New York City Fire Fighters and EMS personnel.
- Over [284 New York Police Department officers](#) and over 226 FDNY Firefighters have reportedly died of their 9/11 injuries since 9/11 and more are expected in the coming years.
- To date, the September 11 Victim Compensation Fund has received [56,277 eligibility claims](#).
- The VCF, since being reopened, has made over [31,690](#) determinations for injured and ill responders and survivors or their families totaling over [\\$7.1 Billion](#).
- The VCF has claims from all [fifty states](#).
